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PASE A BRIEF HISTORY



Boreham Wood Football Club are a non-league community club who play in the Ryman Premier Division. The club started a football/education scheme back in 2002 with sixteen boys. Oaklands College came on board in 2005 and since that time the scheme has become the largest and most successful scheme of its kind in the United Kingdom.

When the club first started PASE (**P**rogramme for **A**cademic and **S**porting Excellence) our aim was simple... we wanted to stop talented young footballers from falling through the net, and give them a chance to progress their talent with top quality coaching. More importantly the club felt that we could create an environment where many of these young men could continue their education and achieve a higher education qualification, as the majority of these scholars would not have continued in their studies.

The scheme has grown steadily over the past seven years, and we now have 250 young scholars, who play their football here at BWFC and are educated on nine separate education sites in and around the North London and South Hertfordshire areas.



The club has been extremely successful on the football front, with over 200 boys from the scheme now playing semi-professional football within the non-league pyramid. We also have other boys now playing professional football.

Presently we have 3 boys representing England schools and colleges at various levels. As well as a number of boys who represent their respective counties. As I'm sure you can imagine, this is a great honour for both the boys and the club.

On the competition front we are now one of the most successful Semi-professional Clubs in the entire Country. Some of the competitions we have won include:- 'The Southern Counties Floodlit Youth League' for the last 3 years. The 'National Conference Cup' (second only to the FA Youth Cup in terms of prestige) we have in fact reached the final 3 times in the last 5 years. Then there are the county cups and a number of other league affiliated cups and competitions, which we continue to win.

We once again reached the FA Youth Cup, First Round Proper for the third season in a row, which is when the professional Academies enter the competition. In the last two years we have reached the first and then second round of the FA Youth Cup, finally succumbing to talented teams from Leyton Orient and a Swansea City side which included six Welsh Schoolboy Internationals. We gave a great account of ourselves in each of the games, and were unlucky not to come away with a result in both

Presently we feel we have a particularly gifted group of young men. In fact we set up a number of prestigious friendlies with sides from Tottenham Hotspur, Watford Football Club, Leyton Orient and Luton Town to everyone's delight, we only lost one game and won the other three!

With this in mind, we hope that the next two years, will be our most successful to date and we will aim at going the furthest in our history in the FA Youth Cup... This would be achieved by reaching the third round proper where we would hope to meet Premiership opposition.

We are well regarded within the professional football community, and many of our boys are now with or being looked at by professional clubs.

The success seen at BWFC in football terms is unparalleled in the Non-League game, but the most important part to our scheme is actually the education and this also makes our work more rewarding.

We want you to value education highly, so no matter how talented you are as a player you must understand you will not play a minute of football, unless you are up to date with all assignments and coursework in your subjects. We believe this policy teaches all boys that hard work is rewarded, and to get something good out of life you have to put hard work into it!

The facts are that many of our boys, unfortunately will not be good enough to make the cut as professional footballers. So it is vital that the boys enjoy their, Football but achieve a qualification that they can use in the wider world after their time on the scheme.

We have now educated and coached over eight-hundred scholars. Who have either worked towards their qualifications at the club, or have graduated with higher education credentials, including construction courses, A-levels or B-TEC Diplomas. Another six boys last September went gone off to University, which is again wonderful progression when you consider that many of these boys would have left school and not continued with their education.



The professionalism and facilities the club has developed and improved over the years, is critical in making the scheme possible. The club has a full time medical department, which deals with all the players injury, fitness and nutrition concerns... We have six UEFA and FA licensed coaches... A fully stocked rehabilitation gym... Andy Gray smart boards, enabling us to review matches and go through tactics and patterns of play with the boys... We have in house classrooms with computers for the students to catch up on assignments... We have a student canteen and we have three new mini buses for away travel and post match drops off points for players....

The changes at BWFC have been truly dramatic and again this is only possible with the help of our partners Oaklands College, Enfield College, The BeauSandVer Group, our main sponsors Cardif Pinnacle plus Elstree & Borehamwood Town council and Hertsmere Borough Council. We hope with the continued support of our partners, that we can continue to improve the PASE Scheme and to continue the clubs progress. With their help we can change and improve the lives of so many student / footballers.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



How long is the course?

The Courses last from 1 to 3 years, dependant on your age, course chosen and GCSE grades.

Who is it for?

It is for boys who are between 16-18 years of age that want to further their knowledge, understanding and ability in football whilst at the same time continuing their education.

What qualification will I gain?

PASE provides you with the opportunity to gain a BTEC in Sport qualification, gain a qualification in construction, or we also offer A-Level courses.

Each student will also gain further additionality qualifications in Drug awareness, exercise and fitness and the opportunity to pass their level 1 or 2 coaching badges.



Where do I Study?

Where you study will depend on which course you enrol on and where you live. Whether your on a BTEC in Sport, the multi-trade courses, or doing A-Level courses, you will study at a campus in either Borehamwood, Smallford, St Albans or Enfield College. (Please note our A-Level schools or college are all in the St Albans area)

Where do I train?

We have a new 3rd Generation astro turf that all of your coaching sessions will take place on at Boreham Wood Football Club. We also have an onsite gymnasium and onsite classrooms, to help with your additional coaching courses and education. We also have 3 other grass pitches located at Smallford and Enfield. With 2 other college gymnasiums available for the students benefit.

What type of training will I receive to help me progress?

Training will be based on improving you as players on ALL aspects of the game, with sessions concentrating on a players Technique, control, tactical awareness, to name but a few. This may also involve footage of your very own PASE games that will be played back to you on an "Andy Gray" style Smart Board as well as additionalities and advice on Nutrition and fitness regimes, from our medical department.

Am I supplied with kit?

We do not allow you to train in "whatever you want", so you will be expected to purchase a training set from us. This includes a tracksuit, rain jacket, jumper, polo shirt, training top, training shorts, training socks, and kit bag which is Subsidised to reduce the cost to £100 (this is the only football cost you will incur from us). However the college do have course expenses that can total between £30 - £90 dependant on your course

Who will be teaching me?

Fully qualified Tutors will be responsible for helping you gain your academic grades, whilst your football coaching will be taken by our Licensed Coaches, who have experience in Professional and YTS Schemes, as well as playing at a professional level.

Am I medically looked after?

DEFINITELY is the answer. We use an independent company Elite performance, that caters for all your physiotherapy needs. We currently have a team of physio's, a new physio clinic with state of the art equipment, and a fully functional gym. Which will ensure all our players have the expert help and advice they need...





CAN BOREHAM WOOD FC HELP ME?



For anyone to progress as an individual, it is mainly down to you as a person! However if you show the right attitude, discipline, desire and application, then we believe we can take you as far as your ability will allow.

We currently have strong relationships and links with various professional and semi professional clubs within the non-league and league pyramid.



We also have a number personal relationships and ties with professional clubs at various levels of the pro game, clubs such as Watford, Reading, Leyton Orient, Peterborough Utd, Colchester United, Norwich City and Dagenham & Redbridge to name just a few.

Throughout the season we put on prestigious friendlies , which allow us to gauge how far a player has developed.

This season alone we have staged friendlies against Tottenham Hotspur, Watford, Leyton Orient, Dagenham & Redbridge and Peterborough.

At PASE & Elite level, our club is structured, so that our students gain the experience of playing in the Conference Youth League, this obviously helps targeting the National Cup competitions.

Year on year we boast one of the strongest teams in the South of England at this level. Having lost just once in the National conference cup in the last three years. We are once again in the Semi Final of this years competition, with high hopes again of lifting this prestigious trophy!

We are the only team in Hertfordshire and North London to do so and we are very proud of our record...

Our training programme is aimed at improving players on ALL aspects of the game. With sessions concentrating on a Players Technique, Control and Tactical awareness, to name but a few. This will also involve footage of games that will be played back to you on an "Andy Gray" style Smart Board. To show and point out mistakes, awareness, pattern of play etc.

Each year we also look to improve ourselves, we have a team of highly qualified coaches. Our coaches boast between them the playing experience, that includes Professional football, Conference football. In fact our 1st Team manager Mr Ian Allinson, also played over 500 games in the football league whilst playing for Arsenal over 100 times.



Our PASE Scheme and youth structure can also boast player progression into the Pro game. With lads who have come through our individually designed football structure, to sign professional contracts at Crystal Palace, Watford, Barnet, Dagenham & Redbridge and others...



INTERNATIONAL PLAYER SUCCESS



Boreham Wood Football Club this season has seen great success in the England National Representative sides for the England Independent Schools, England Schools and England College's.

We currently have two players in the National England College side, in Jon Clements and Jay Brett. Both won England caps in the 3 – 0 victory against Wales. These lads will also represent the England College team in a very prestigious tour of Italy, where they could face the National under 19 sides from Italy, Holland, Germany, Slovenia, Romania & Greece.

We also have last seasons under 16 ISFA (independent Schools) captain, Charlie Hunter. Charlie has now been selected this season for the ISFA under 18 side. He has already represented his country in the 6 – 0 thrashing of Shropshire Schools, and played in international fixtures against Australia and Wales. He will tour Poland with the England ISFA squad before playing against Scotland in another full international fixture, North of the border.

We also had two first year under 18s, Liam Griffin and Lee Close, who were selected for final trials with England for the English Schools football Association. These boys spent 3 days at Lilleshall and we hope they continue the fantastic progress they've shown and will hopefully Represent England shortly.

Boreham Wood FC regard it as a great honour, to have more England National representative players this season than any other team within the Non-League pyramid. That's a credit to Boreham Wood FC's structure, our coaches and of course the progress of the players who have worked so hard to represent their Country on a National level.

To add to that success, a total of 14 players have made the BWFC first team squad, with 8 players this season making first team debuts.

Since the PASE Scheme started in 2002, we have had many players who have reached our first team squad, and to date we have over 100 players who have gone on to play at the very top level of the non-league pyramid.

One of our old youth team players who has stepped into the professional game, is Lee Hodson, Lee currently plays regular first team football for Watford FC. As a youngster Lee came through our youth structure and we are very happy we played a part in his progress

Boreham Wood also have other players who have gone to the United States of America on scholarships, to study within the American College and university system. So the world really is your oyster if you study hard, as well as apply yourself to football.

THE TRAINING SITES BOREHAM WOOD



Location

Boreham Wood Football Club is based in the south of Hertfordshire / North London area, with easy access from the surrounding areas. This site is very accessible by public transport, Via Borehamwood and Elstree train station thameslink line which can be reached from any area of North London within 45 minutes, and also by the 107 & 292 bus routes.

Facilities

Boreham Wood Football Club is a top quality football and Education facility that includes a full size 3rd generation football pitch that will be used for many training sessions. It will also be used for in house and Football Conference fixtures.

We also have 6 football league standard size changing rooms to accommodate for the high volume of training sessions and games played on a weekly basis.

Our training complex also boasts a gymnasium and will be used for indoor core stability and circuit training and also for players receiving rehab during time of injury.



On top of these facilities the Boreham Wood site, also uses the Andy Gray style Smart Board technology, which will be utilised for discussions on tactics, team shape, team dynamics, match preparation and also one on one tuition. This technology is also used for post game analysis to discuss key factors from previous matches. This has proved to be very effective as it gives the players a visual and tactical side to their development.

Location

Enfield Centre is located in Ponders End with very easy access from the Tottenham, Edmonton, Waltham Cross and Enfield Town Centre, and can be easily accessed by 121, 279 and 307 bus routes or short walks from Brimsdown or Southbury rail stations.

Facilities

The Enfield football site has many excellent facilities that include a full size grass pitch and training area. These will be used for all outdoor training sessions, in house games Plus our English College League and Football Conference fixtures, with 4 changing rooms to accommodate training sessions and fixtures on a weekly basis.



The training complex also boasts a gymnasium and this will be used for indoor core stability and also for players receiving rehab during time of injury.

It also boasts an Indoor sports hall which will ensure there are no disruptions to your training schedule during periods of bad Weather and finally there is an indoor workout Studio, which will be used for circuit fitness training and pre match meetings.

On top of this, the Enfield site, also possess the Andy Gray style Smart Board technology, which will be utilised for discussions on team tactics, team shape, team dynamics, match preparation and one on one tuition.

This technology is also used in post match analysis to discuss key factors from previous matches. This has proved to be a very effective tool as it gives the players a visual and tactical side to their development.

Construction

Basic Construction Skills Certificate City & Guilds Level 1

This course has been designed by City & Guilds to provide basic training and is ideal if you are seeking employment in the construction industry. You will gain experience in three construction trades: brickwork, carpentry and joinery, and painting and decorating. This course is suitable if you are 16 to 18 years old and have no previous experience or knowledge of the construction industry.

Sports Courses

Sport OCR First Certificate Level 1

This course is an ideal introduction to the industry if you are interested in a career in sport and leisure. You will need 2 GCSEs at grade A* – F or a pass on an Entry Level course.

Sport OCR National Certificate Level 2

This course is ideal if you are interested in a career in the sport and leisure industries. You must have good literacy and research skills. A strong interest in sport, sport science and the business of the sports industry is essential for you to succeed on this course. You will need 3 GCSEs at grade A* – D or a Level 1 qualification at Merit grade.

Sport BTEC National Certificate (Development and Fitness) Level 3

This course is ideal if you are seeking a career in the leisure and sports industries or further study at university. You must have good literacy and research skills. A strong interest in sport and the business of the sports industry is essential for you to succeed on this course.
